1 About The School Fund Scholarships

The School Fund is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving access to education in Kenya and other countries. Our mission is to ensure that every student, no matter where they are born, has the opportunity to attend school. The School Fund provides scholarships for high achieving students to attend secondary school through U-Tena Youth Organization in Kenya.

A scholarship with The School Fund includes Payment for school fees from Form 2, Form 3 and Form 4. Scholarship may be up to the maximum of Ksh 20,000 per year which will be used for school fees only

A) Successful applicants for a scholarship through The School Fund will:

- I. Be unable to afford the fees to attend secondary school;
- II. Have completed primary school and passed the Examination to enter secondary school
- III. Be in the top 15% of their class as determined by their class rank or examination scores;
- IV. Exhibit personal qualities of leadership, compassion, and determination;

B) Being selected for a scholarship with The School Fund is only the first step in the relationship between The School Fund and student scholars. By being selected as a scholar, students are committing to try their hardest in school, keep in touch with The School Fund community, take advantage of educational opportunities, and be leaders in their classes and communities. We ask all of our scholars to commit to a few key requirements for maintaining their scholarship. Failure to meet these criteria could result in The School Fund revoking a scholarship.

- I. Student must write in their online journals at least six times a year and all scholars must keep The School Fund community updated on their studies and life.
- II. Students must maintain grades in the top 15% of their class.
- III. Students must send us the transcript/report form at end of each school term
